## *Loon Lake Improvement Plan*

The Waseca Soil and Water Conservation District has given preliminary approval to the WLA to clean up and beautify the Loon Lake shoreline by clearing unwanted vegetation and planting aquatic plants. A grant of up to \$15,000 will be used to purchase aquatic and shore land plant material. Experts from the DNR will help to facilitate the program, while the WLA responsibility will be to supply labor for planting and maintenance. Please plan to attend the informational meetings scheduled for March 18<sup>th</sup> and April 13<sup>th</sup>.
